

If you knew your next gig would be the last one you'd ever get to play in your life, what tune would you want to close out the show with??

This is a difficult question... To which few will know the answer!

A few years back there was a great guy playing around here by the name of Ray Bushbaum. Ray played super piano and sang and loved blues and R & B big time. He was from Toledo, Ohio but played a lot of his career in Seattle before he and his wife moved to Ajijic.

Ray was diagnosed with a brain tumor that would take him and he had to slow down a bit but his wife put on a "last show" which was professionally videoed and with great sound at the Piano Rojo which was a couple of blocks south of the Ajijic Plaza with about 100 of his friends there.

The band was called Best Kept Secret and featured with Ray, the late Jay Shuffle on harmonica and vocals and as good a rhythm section anywhere with Sergio Casas on bass and Chelo González on drums. It was a fabulous evening. But as the clipping at the top asks, I wondered what Ray would do for his last tune... he did a fabulous rendition of a

song Louie Armstrong recorded called "I've Got All The Time in the World" and brought the house down... I don't think there was a dry eye in the place.

As I mentioned, the late and very great Jay Shuffle was in that band and a couple of years later he and Paul Brier and I (The Great American Songbook originals) were hired to play Valentine's Day at Adelita's. When Jay didn't show up to move the equipment we really didn't think much of it as we heard he was seeing a new gal... we had to start the gig without him but knowing it wasn't like Jay some friends went by his place but found him passed away. One of Jay's favorite songs was The Night Life and I bet if given the chance... he would have wanted to play that.

Both wonderful and very talented guys and dearly missed by all that knew them.

At 76 one thinks about this but unless it's written on stone... let it pass. Ray has really been the only one I have known who knew it would be his last performance.


